At times, the cost goes higher. The very reason is that their cartridges incur a higher production cost. Even when there are partner companies that manufacture the ink refills and their cartridges but still the production expense is relatively more expensive.

Meanwhile, the other kind of inkjet cartridge is made up of a plastic container. It bears a sponge inside it wherein the ink gets injected. The good side is that it makes for a less costly cartridge. In reality, the companies that produce the ink refill substitutes are able to save up to 25% compared to the other type of cartridge. You don't have much to worry though since they are still of the inkjet type so you are assured that the print quality is truly excellent.

Some Printing Considerations

It is for the reason of the high cost of the cartridge that some buyers entertain second thoughts. The thing is, there are a lot of other factors that you must keep in mind to prevent any damage on your printer and any waste of money on your part. Take note of the following reminders.

If there is no tough demand for printing, be sure to run the ink cartridge at least once a week or once in every two weeks to avoid the drying out of the ink.

Clean the printer in and out at least once a week to avoid the risk of clogging.

Replace the cartridge as soon as the ink runs out.

Find the perfect match for your ink cartridge. Never make the mistake of buying one that doesn't agree with your printer's specifications.

Overall, the inkjet printers and inks are widely available. By shopping online you can have more chances of procuring the best buys.
